British soprano **Gemma Summerfield** was awarded First Prize at the 2022 Tenor Viñas Contest and the 2019 Concorso Lirico Internazionale di Portofino, and was a finalist in the inaugural Glyndebourne Opera Cup in 2018.

In the 2022/23 season she sings **Erste Dame** *Die Zauberflöte* for Staatsoper Hamburg, **Fiordiligi** *Così fan tutte* for Opéra de Toulon and **Ulana** *MANRU* for Opéra national de Lorraine. She also performs Delius *A Mass for Life* with Bergen Philharmonic Orchestra.

Recent operatic engagements include **Mimi** *La bohème* (Northern Ireland Opera); **Fiordiligi** *Così fan tutte* (Opéra national du Rhin); **Pamina** *The Magic Flute* and cover **Michal** *Saul* (Glyndebourne Festival Opera); **Nannetta** *Falstaff* and **Pamina** *The Magic Flute* (Scottish Opera); **Paula Jordan** in the European premiere of William Bolcom's *Dinner at Eight* (Wexford Festival Opera); **Fiordiligi** *Così fan tutte* (Bury Court Opera); **Barmherzigkeit** in Mozart's *Die Schuldigkeit des ersten Gebots*, **Hyacinthus** in Mozart's *Apollo et Hyacinthus* and Mozart's *Grabmusik* (all for Classical Opera); cover title role **Rodelinda** (English National Opera); **Gretel** *Hänsel und Gretel* (Royal College of Music International Opera School); **Ginevra** *Ariodante* (RCM / London Handel Festival); **Rosalinde** *Die Fledermaus*, **First Lady** *Die Zauberflöte* and **La Chauve-Souris/Une Pastourelle** *L'enfant et les sortilèges* (all RCM); **Berenice** *Il Vologeso* (Classical Opera at the Cadogan Hall); and **Donna Elvira** *Don Giovanni* (Verbier Festival Academy and Euphonia).

On the concert platform, her recent highlights include an in concert performance with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra at Cadogan Hall, in a Carols by Candlelight tour with the Mozart Festival Orchestra and Chorus, debuts with the

Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment, and the Hallé; Bach's *B Minor Mass* (The Bach Choir); Beethoven's *Symphony No.9* (Orchestre de Chambre de Lausanne); Bach's *Magnificat*, *B Minor Mass* and *St John Passion* (all for the Al Bustan Festival, Lebanon); Fauré's *Messe Basse* in Paris; Orff's *Carmina Burana* (Glasgow City Halls); Mendelssohn's *Elijah* (Holy Trinity, Sloane Square); Pergolesi's *Stabat Mater* (RCM); and Bach's *Magnificat in D Major* and *Christmas Cantata* (Dunkeld Cathedral). Also an active recitalist, her recent appearances include recitals at the Oxford Lieder Festival, Leeds Lieder, Cambridge Summer Music; Stratford-upon-Avon and London's Wigmore Hall.

Summerfield has taken part in masterclasses with Barbara Frittoli, Leo Nucci, Richard Bonyng, Sarah Connolly, Dame Felicity Palmer; Edith Wiens; Susan Bullock; Patricia MacMahon; Joan Rodgers; and renowned accompanists Malcolm Martineau, Roger Vignoles, Jonathan Papp and Anne Le Bozec.

Summerfield studied at the Royal College of Music International Opera School, the Georg Solti Accademia and the Verbier Festival Academy. She is a Yeomen of the Worshipful Company of Musicians and a recipient of their Silver Medal. Further competition successes include the 2018 Susan Chilcott Award for Singers, the Jean Meikle Prize for a Duo at the 2017 Wigmore Hall International Song Competition, and First Prize and the Song Prize at the 2015 Kathleen Ferrier Awards.
