

## Barbe & Doucet

## Dramaturgy, Stage Direction, Choreography, Sets & Costumes Design

After separate beginnings in dance, theatre, television, circus and the opera field, Renaud Doucet, Stage director & Choreographer and André Barbe, Set & Costume Designer, have created over forty new opera productions that are recognised for their creativity, sense spectacle and minutely detailed dramaturgy.

André Barbe received a Bachelor of Fine Arts at Concordia University then studied at the National Theatre School of Canada under the tutelage of designer François Barbeau. Up to now, he has designed over 300 productions

for theatre, television and opera. He received the Irish Times Irish Theatre Award for best designer for the production of Pénélope at Wexford Festival Opera as well as the Rolf-Mares Prize for best sets and costumes for the production of La Cenerentola at the Hamburgische Staatsoper. Since 2010, he is regularly invited to teach Set and Costume design at the National Theatre School of Canada.

Trained musician Renaud Doucet began his performing career as a solo dancer, ballet master, teacher and choreographer in international dance companies. He was introduced to the opera world as a baroque choreographer and baroque specialist, coaching singers such as, Alfredo Kraus, Jaime Aragall, Raina Kabaivanska and Mirella Freni. He also worked as an actor in various films and television series. Now, he is regularly invited to teach young singers and pianists in various opera programs such as the Manhattan School of Music, the Hamburg Staatsoper Opernstudio, l'Atelier lyrique de l'Opéra de Montréal.

Their work as a team has gained international recognition with their new productions of Die Zauberflöte at the Glyndebourne Festival, La Cenerentola, La belle Hélène and Die Fledermaus at the Staatsoper Hamburg, La fille du régiment at Teatro La Fenice and Teatro Regio di Torino, Il signor Bruschino at the Rossini Opera Festival and Teatro Comunale di Bologna, La Cenerentola at the Latvian National Opera and Opéra National du Capitole de Toulouse, Pelléas et Mélisande at the Teatro Regio di Parma and l'Opéra Royal de Wallonie, Samson and Dalila at the Kungliga Operan in Stockholm, Die Feen for Oper Leipzig in coproduction with the Bayreuther Festspiele, Les contes d'Hoffmann at Oper Bonn and Volksoper Wien, Pénélope, Si j'étais roi, Thérèse/La Navarraise and Il bravo at the Wexford Festival Opera, Arabella and La Grande-Duchesse de Gérolstein at Oper Köln, Cendrillon at l'Opéra National du Rhin in Strasbourg, l'Opéra de Marseille, New York Opera, Badisches Staatstheater Karlsruhe and L'Opéra de Montréal, the Viennese premiere of The Sound of Music Turandot and Rusalka at the Volksoper Wien, Benvenuto Cellini and Iphigénie en Aulide at l'Opéra National du Rhin, Il Matrimonio segreto at the Innsbrucker Festwochen der Alten Musik and Oper Köln, Turandot at Opera Philadelphia, Seattle Opera, Minnesota Opera, Atlanta Opera, Utah Opera, Cincinnati Opera and Vancouver Opera, La Bohème at Scottish Opera, Theatre St Gallen, Vancouver Opera, Opéra national du Capitole de Toulouse, Manon at the Scottish Opera and Malmö Opera, the entire 2009-10 season of Florida Grand Opera in Miami with Lucia di Lammermoor, Pagliacci, Suor Angelica, Il barbiere di Siviglia and Carmen; Don Pasquale at Scottish Opera, Florida Grand Opera, Teatro Carlo Felice in Genova, Oper Kiel, Vancouver Opera and Canadian Opera Company.

In 2019, their production of *Il Bravo*, received the Irish Times Theatre Award for Best Opera Production.
