Bass David Soar was born in Nottinghamshire, England, and studied singing and organ at the Royal Academy of Music.

Recent engagements on the opera stage include **Fasolt** in *Das Rheingold*, **Judge** Turpin in Sweeney Todd, both for Opernhaus Zürich, **Hobson** in *Peter* Grimes for English National Opera, **Capulet** in a new production of *Roméo et* Juliette for Opernhaus Zürich; **Colline** in La bohème, **Lodovico** in *Otello*. Sprecher in Die Zauberflöte, and Mr **Flint** in *Billy Budd* for the Royal Opera House; Colline for The Metropolitan Opera; **Mr. Flint** for the Glyndebourne Festival Opera, and Madrid's Teatro Real; Sir Walter Raleigh in Gloriana for Teatro Real and English National Opera: Animal Trainer/Athlete in Lulu for English National Opera; Escamillo in Carmen for Glyndebourne and Welsh National Opera; **Figaro** in *Le nozze di* Figaro, Leporello in Don Giovanni, **Sparafucile** in *Rigoletto*, and the **Doctor** in Wozzeck for Welsh National Opera, and Cadmus and Somnus in Handel's Semele with Garsington Opera.

Equally in demand on the concert platform, David's engagements have included Beethoven's Christus am Ölberge with both the London Symphony Orchestra and Berlin Philharmonic Orchestra led by Sir Simon Rattle; **Harapha** in Handel's *Samson* at the Edinburgh Festival; Elgar's The Dream of Gerontius with the BBC Symphony Orchestra, Seattle Symphony Orchestra, and the BBC Scottish Symphony Orchestra: Mendelssohn's Elijah with the Royal Flemish Philharmonic Orquesta y Coro Nacionales de España; Weihnachts-Oratorium Bach's with Northern Sinfonia: Royal Berlioz' **Méphistophélè**s in La

Damnation de Faust with the Orchestra of Opera North; Kurt Weill's The Seven Deadly Sins with Hallé Orchestra; Walton's Belshazzar's Feast with the BBC Philharmonic Orchestra; and **Bauer** in Schönberg's Gurre-Lieder with The Philharmonia.

David's discography includes the world premiere recording (2019) of Havergal Brian's Faust (Orchestra of English National Opera / Martyn Brabbins); Gramphone award-winning The Dream of Gerontius, and Berlioz's Roméo et Juliette for Chandos (BBC Symphony Orchestra/Sir Andrew Davis); Stanford's Stabat Mater for Naxos (Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra/David Stravinsky's Threni (Royal Flemish Philharmonic/Phillippe Herreweghe), and Adriana Lecouvreur on DVD for Opus Arte with Angela Gheorghiu and Jonas Kaufmann (Royal Opera House Orchestra/Sir Mark Elder).

In the 2025-2026 season, he returns to San Francisco Opera as **Titurel in** Parsifal and Utah Opera as **Rocco** in Fidelio. He also performs Handel's Messiah with the Rhode Island Philharmonic Orchestra.
